ORDER

At Bluefield, on March 19, 2018, came the United States of America by Miller Bushong, Assistant United States Attorney, and also came the defendant in person and by court-appointed counsel, David R. Bungard, Assistant Federal Public Defender, for the purpose of a Preliminary and Detention Hearing as previously ordered by the Court. Also present was Brett Taylor, Senior United States Probation Officer.


The Court, having heard the testimony of a witness, found probable cause to believe that the defendant committed the offense charged in the *Criminal Complaint*, a violation of 18 U.S.C. §922(a)(6) and 18 U.S.C. §922(g)(4). Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the defendant shall appear for further proceedings.

The Court proceeded to the Detention Hearing in this matter. Following proffers and arguments of counsel and the factors contained in 18 U.S.C. §3142(g), the Court found the defendant is not a suitable candidate for release. The Court found by clear and convincing evidence that the defendant is a danger to others and the community. The Court further found that there is no condition or combination of conditions of release that will reasonable assure the safety

of others and the community. Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the defendant is detained and remanded to the custody of the United States Marshal pending further proceedings.

The Court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to provide a copy of this Order to the defendant and counsel, to the Assistant United States Attorney, to the United States Probation Office, and to the Office of the United States Marshals Service.
